DISCONTINUATION OF ENFORCEMENT UNDERTAKINGS

BACKGROUND:

NHS Improvement (as was) accepted enforcement undertakings under section 106 of the Health and Social Care Act 2012 from the Licensee on 23 March 2018 ("the Undertakings").

NHS England and the Licensee agree that it is not appropriate to continue the Undertakings currently in force with respect to Finance and A&E Performance due to the passage of time and changes in the Licensee's circumstances.

In this document, "NHS Improvement" means Monitor, which was abolished and its functions transferred to NHS England on 1 July 2022 by the Health and Care Act 2022. Any reference to the "Undertakings" means the Undertakings as may have been varied from time to time.

UNDERTAKINGS TO BE DISCONTINUED:

NHS England and the Licensee agree to discontinue all of the section titled "Undertakings" in the Undertakings.

APPENDIX B

NOTICE OF REMOVAL OF SECTION 111 ADDITIONAL LICENCE CONDITION

LICENSEE:

Wirral University Teaching Hospital NHS Foundation Trust ("the Licensee")

The following additional licence condition was imposed by NHS Improvement¹ on the Licensee on 7 August 2015 in accordance with NHS Improvement's power under section 111 of the Health and Social Care Act 2012:

"Additional Licence Condition 1 – Additional governance requirements:

- 1. The Licensee must ensure that it has in place sufficient and effective Board, management and clinical leadership capacity and capability, as well as appropriate governance systems and processes, to enable it to: a. address the issues specified in paragraph 2 effectively; and b. comply with any discretionary requirement imposed or enforcement undertaking accepted under the 2012 Act in connection with those issues.
- 2. The issues referred to in paragraph 1 are:
 - a. the Licensee's financial position and the need to secure the delivery of its services on a financially sustainable basis;
 - b. the need to ensure compliance with the A&E four-hour maximum waiting time target on a sustainable basis; and
 - c. any other issues relating to governance or operations that have caused or contributed to, or are causing or contributing to, or will cause or

contribute to, the breaches, or the risk of breach, of the conditions of the Licensee's licence.

3. For the purposes of paragraph 1, an issue is addressed effectively only if it is addressed within a reasonable timescale, including any applicable timescale proposed in any discretionary requirement or any enforcement undertaking, or reasonably specified by Monitor."

NHS England has decided it is appropriate to remove this additional licence condition, as from the date of this notice, for the following reasons:

- NHS England is satisfied that the financial governance risk can be adequately mitigated by established ICB monitoring and oversight.
- NHS England has decided to discontinue the enforcement undertakings in respect of A&E performance.
